19 THE PARTIES STIPULATE AS FOLLOWS:

20 1. This Stipulation, Decision, and Order (“Stipulation”) is made and entered
21 into by and between Audrey Joseph and the San Francisco Ethics Commission (“the
22 Commission”).
23

24 2. Respondent and the Commission agree to settle and resolve all factual and
25 legal issues in this matter and to reach a final disposition without an administrative
26

1 hearing. Upon approval of this Stipulation and full performance of the terms outlined in
2 this Stipulation, the Commission will take no future action against Respondent, and this
3 Stipulation shall constitute the complete resolution of all claims by the Commission
4 against Respondent related to the violations of law described in Exhibit A. Respondent
5 understands and knowingly and voluntarily waives all rights to judicial review of this
6 Stipulation and any action taken by the Commission or its staff on this matter.

9 3. Respondent acknowledges responsibility for and agrees to pay an
10 administrative penalty in the amount of Four Hundred and Sixty-Five Dollars (\$465) for
11 one violation of the San Francisco Campaign and Governmental Conduct Code (the "SF
12 C&GCC") section 3.216(b) and an administrative penalty in the amount of Two Thousand
13 and Eighty-Five Dollars (\$2,085) for one violation of SF C&GCC section 3.216(b)(2), as set
14 forth in Exhibit A. Respondent agrees that \$2,550 is a reasonable administrative penalty.

17 4. Within ten (10) business days of the Commission's approval of this
18 Stipulation, Respondent shall deliver to the following address the sum of \$2,550 in the
19 form of a check or money order made payable to the "City and County of San
20 Francisco:"

1 9. In the event the Commission rejects this Stipulation, and further
2 administrative proceedings before the Commission are necessary, Respondent agrees
3 that the Stipulation and all references to it are inadmissible. Respondent moreover
4 agrees not to challenge, dispute, or object to the participation of any member of the
5 Commission or its staff in any necessary administrative proceeding for reasons
6 stemming from his or her prior consideration of this Stipulation.
7

8 10. This Stipulation, along with the attached Exhibit A, reflects the entire
9 agreement between the parties hereto and supersedes any and all prior negotiations,
10 understandings, and agreements with respect to the transactions contemplated herein.
11 This Stipulation may not be amended orally. Any amendment or modification to this
12 Stipulation must be in writing duly executed by all parties and approved by the
13 Commission at a regular or special meeting.
14

15 11. This Stipulation shall be construed under, and interpreted in accordance
16 with, the laws of the State of California. If any provision of the Stipulation is found to be
17 unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall remain valid and enforceable.
18

19 12. The parties hereto may sign different copies of this Stipulation, which will
20 be deemed to have the same effect as though all parties had signed the same
21 document.

Exhibit A

I. Applicable Law

The San Francisco Campaign & Governmental Conduct Code (SF C&GCC) incorporates the meaning of “gift” found in the Political Reform Act (PRA), Government Code section 81000 *et seq.*, and accompanying regulations. *See* SF C&GCC § 3.216(b)(2). The PRA defines “gift” to mean any payment that confers a personal benefit on the recipient, to the extent that consideration of equal or greater value is not received. Gov’t Code § 82028(a).

The PRA prohibits members of City commissions, including the Entertainment Commission, from accepting gifts from any single source in any calendar year with a total value of more than \$440 in 2014 and \$460 in 2015. *Id.* § 89503(c) (adjusted). SF C&GCC incorporates the PRA’s gift limitations. SF C&GCC § 3.216(b). It likewise designates a commissioner of the Entertainment Commission as a disclosure category 2 employee, subject to personal financial disclosure requirements and the PRA’s gift limitations. *Id.* § 3.1-140.

A member of a commission must file a Statement of Economic Interest (SEI) annually by April 1 disclosing income received by the commissioner in the prior calendar year. Cal. Gov. Code §§ 87200 and 87203 and Cal. Code Regs., tit. 2, § 18723(b)(2). Income includes gifts valued at \$50 or more. Cal. Gov. Code § 87207(a).

II. Summary of Material Facts

Another Planet Entertainment, LLC (“Another Planet”) organizes and hosts the Outside Lands Music Festival (“Outside Lands”) every year in Golden Gate Park in August. Respondent Audrey Joseph served as a Commissioner on the Entertainment Commission from 2003 through 2016. In 2014 and 2015, Respondent Joseph received VIP tickets to Outside Lands.

In 2014, Respondent Joseph received one VIP ticket to Outside Lands from Another Planet. The gift limit in 2014 was \$440 and the ticket had a total value of \$595. Respondent Joseph reported receiving the ticket as a gift on her 2014 annual SEI on March 31, 2015 and reported the value as \$600. *See* Exhibit B; p. 3. Respondent Joseph stated she paid Another Planet for her ticket in an amount that brought the value of the ticket below the gift limit. However, Respondent Joseph was unable to provide documentation to substantiate the claim she paid Another Planet for her ticket in an amount that brought the value of the ticket below the 2014 gift limit.

In 2015, Respondent Joseph received one VIP ticket to Outside Lands from Another Planet. In 2015, the gift limit was \$460 and the ticket had a total value of \$695. Respondent Joseph did not report receiving the ticket as a gift on her 2015 SEI on February 19, 2016. *See* Exhibit C. Again, though, Respondent Joseph stated she paid Another Planet for her ticket in an amount that brought the value of the ticket below the gift limit. Respondent Joseph provided Commission investigators with a copy of her August 14, 2015, American Express credit card statement, which contained a payment on July 27, 2015, to “Outside Lands” in the amount of \$310. This payment brought the value of the gift down to \$385, which is below the \$460 gift limit for 2015.

III. Conclusions of Law

Count 1: SF C&GCC Section 3.216(b)

1. In 2014, Respondent Joseph accepted a gift of a music festival ticket valued at \$595 from Another Planet, which was \$155 more than the gift limit, in violation of SF C&GCC section 3.216(b), incorporating section 89503(c) of the PRA.

Count 2: SF C&GCC Section 3.216(b)(2)

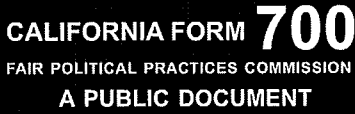
2. In 2015, Respondent Joseph failed to disclose a gift of a music festival ticket valued at \$695 from Another Planet on her 2015 annual SEI, in violation of SF C&GCC section 3.216(b)(2), incorporating sections 87203 and 87207(a) of the PRA.

IV. Penalty Assessment

This matter consists of two violations of the San Francisco Campaign and Governmental Conduct Code section 3.216. The San Francisco Charter authorizes the Commission to assess a maximum administrative penalty of \$5,000 per violation, meaning this matter could amount to a maximum administrative penalty of \$10,000. SF Charter at section C3.699-13(c). Alternatively, the SF Ethics Commission may impose a penalty of three times the value of any unlawfully received gifts. San Francisco Charter section C3.699-13(c)(i)(3).

When determining penalties, the Ethics Commission considers all of the relevant circumstances surrounding the case, including but not limited to: (a) the severity of the violation; (b) the presence or absence of any intention to conceal, deceive, or mislead; (c) whether the violation was deliberate, negligent or inadvertent; (d) whether the violation was an isolated incident or part of a pattern; (e) whether the respondent has a prior record of violations of law; and (f) the degree to which the respondent cooperated with the investigation and demonstrated a willingness to remedy any violations. San Francisco Ethics Commission Regulations for Investigations and Enforcement Proceedings (Enforcement Regulations) section XII.C.2.

Applying the penalty factors enumerated above, Staff believes the Respondent's violation is significant because as a Commissioner, the Respondent completed both Sunshine Ordinance training and Ethics training annually from as early as 2007 to current. Therefore, she should have known she was subject to gift limits and reporting requirements. However, Staff found no evidence Respondent intended to mislead the public. Additionally, Respondent Joseph was cooperative with the investigation. Therefore, Staff recommends imposing an administrative penalty of three times the amount of the unreported gifts as follows: Count 1 - \$465 (\$155 x 3) and Count 2 - \$2,085 (\$695 x 3). Subsequently, the total proposed penalty for Counts 1 and 2 is \$2,550. Assessing penalties of three times the amount of the gift unreported is warranted here due to its likely deterrent effect and because the amount of penalty is proportional to the financial benefit conferred by the acceptance of unlawful gifts.
