15 THE PARTIES STIPULATE AS FOLLOWS:

16 1. This Streamlined Administrative Resolution Program Stipulation, Decision, and Order
17 (Stipulation) is made and entered into by and between Jennifer Stojkovic (Respondent) and the San
18 Francisco Ethics Commission (the Commission).

19 2. Respondent and the Commission agrees to settle and resolve all factual and legal issues
20 in this matter and to reach a final disposition through the Commission’s Streamlined Administrative
21 Resolution Program and without an administrative hearing. Upon approval of this Stipulation and full
22 performance of the terms outlined in this Stipulation, the Commission will take no future action against
23 Respondent, and this Streamlined Stipulation shall constitute the complete resolution of all claims by
24 the Commission against Respondent related to the violations of law described in Exhibit A. Respondent
25 understands and knowingly and voluntarily waives all rights to judicial review of this Streamlined
26 Stipulation and any action taken by the Commission or its staff on this matter.

Description of Respondent: Jennifer Stojkovic is the Executive Director at sf.citi and has made lobbyist contacts for her employer since at least July 2017.

Description of Violation: Since she qualified as a contact lobbyist in January of 2018, Jennifer Stojkovic has made 40 lobbyist contacts on behalf of her employer, sf.citi and has failed to disclose one contact that she made for her employer and the compensation that she received from her employer for her lobbying activity in violation of SF C&GCC section 2.110(c).

Specific Eligibility Requirements: Jennifer Stojkovic must file 22 amended monthly lobbyist reports and disclose one previously unreported contact that she made for her employer and the \$2,871 in total compensation that she received from her employer on the following reports:

- 1) May 2021
- 2) February 2021
- 3) October 2020
- 4) September 2020
- 5) June 2020
- 6) May 2020
- 7) January 2020
- 8) October 2019
- 9) September 2019
- 10) June 2019
- 11) May 2019
- 12) March 2019
- 13) February 2019
- 14) January 2019
- 15) November 2019
- 16) October 2018
- 17) September 2018
- 18) June 2018
- 19) May 2018
- 20) April 2018
- 21) March 2018
- 22) January 2018

and then Jennifer Stojkovic must sign and return this stipulated agreement within 90 days of contact by the Commission’s Enforcement Division.
